

Chesham & Ley Hill Golf Club – Local Rules

1 Out of bounds

- 1.1 A ball coming to rest on or over any road is out of bounds.
- 1.2 A ball coming to rest over any boundary fence is out of bounds.

2 A ball played onto any Tee, other than that of the Hole being played, shall be lifted and dropped off the Tee as near as possible to where the ball lay, but not nearer the Hole, without penalty.

3 Hoof marks may be treated as Ground under Repair – Rule 25 applies.

4 A match at the 10th Tee has alternate precedence over a match about to start on the 1st Tee.

5 A ball coming to rest on, or within one yard either side, of the tarmac driveway crossing the 5th/14th Holes may be lifted and dropped according to Rule 24-2b.

6 Fixed sprinkler heads, metal stopcocks, covers and concrete standpipe covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2.

Important: Players should refer to the Rule Book in the Clubhouse for a complete list of the current Local Rules.
